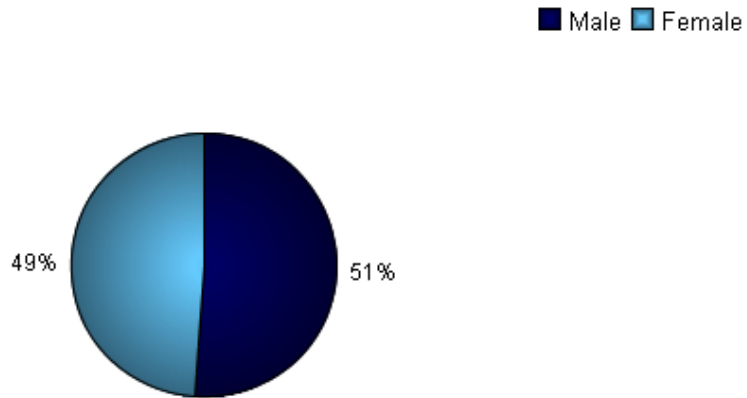

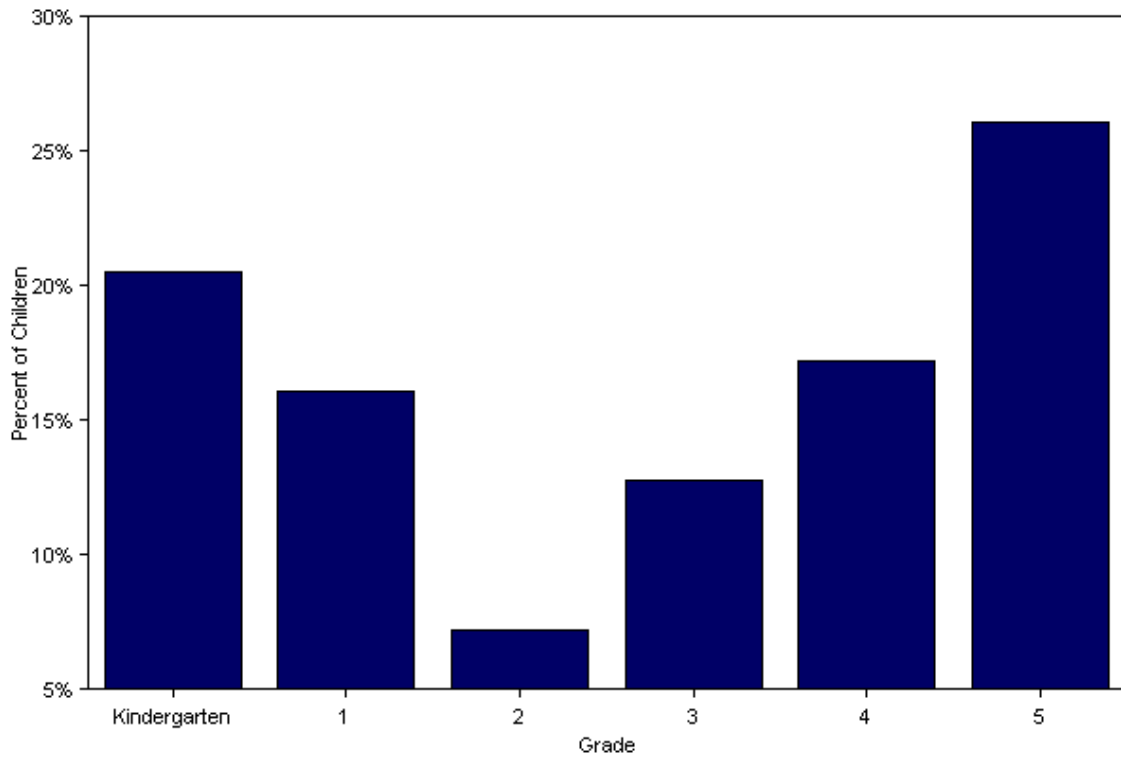

Grade levels of children represented in survey

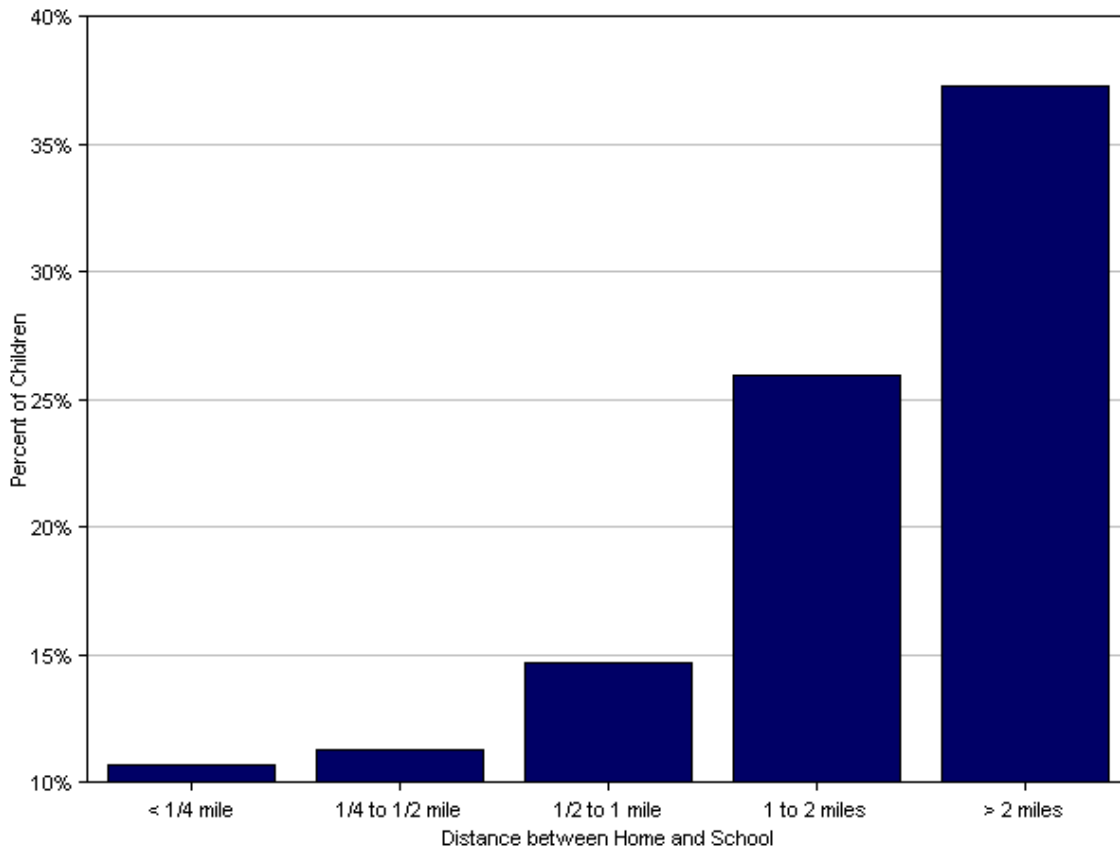

Parent estimate of distance from child's home to school

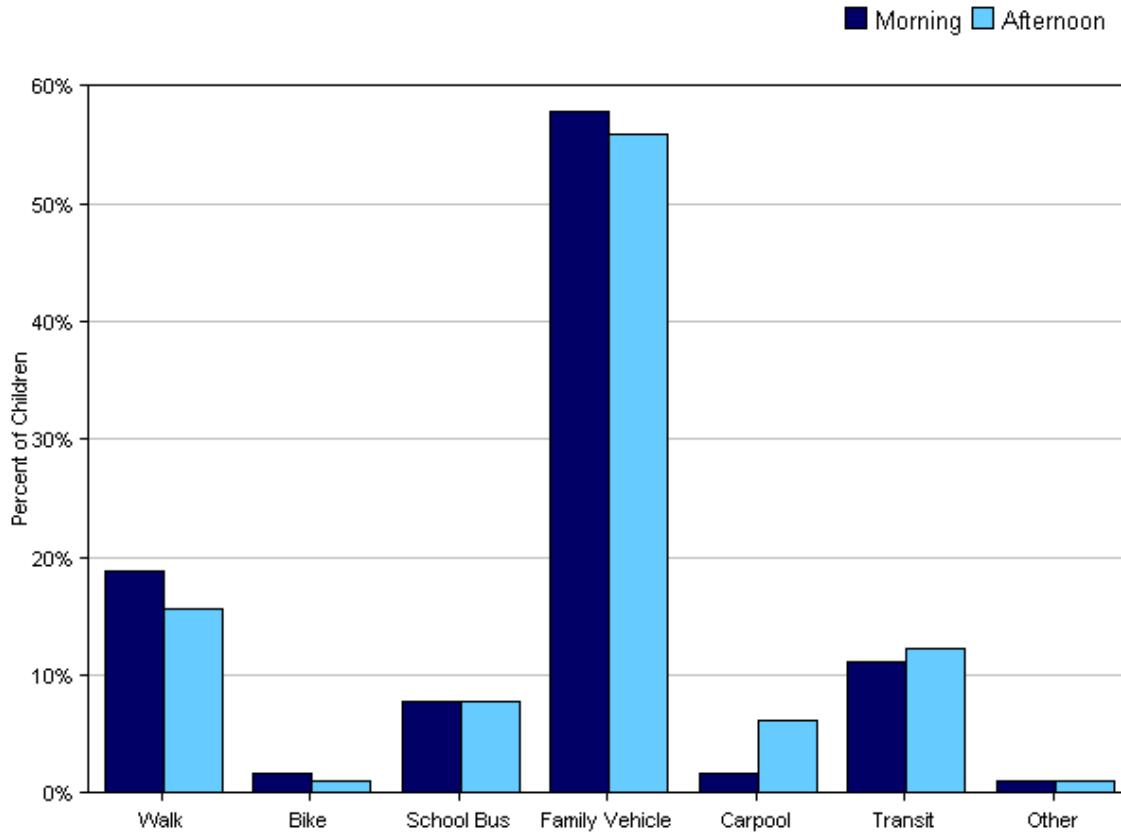

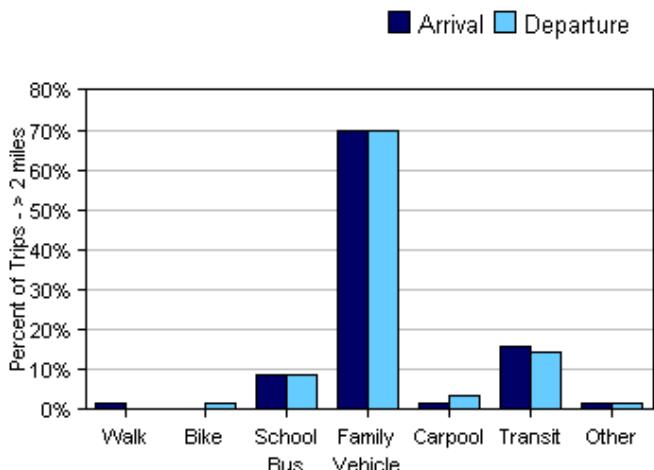

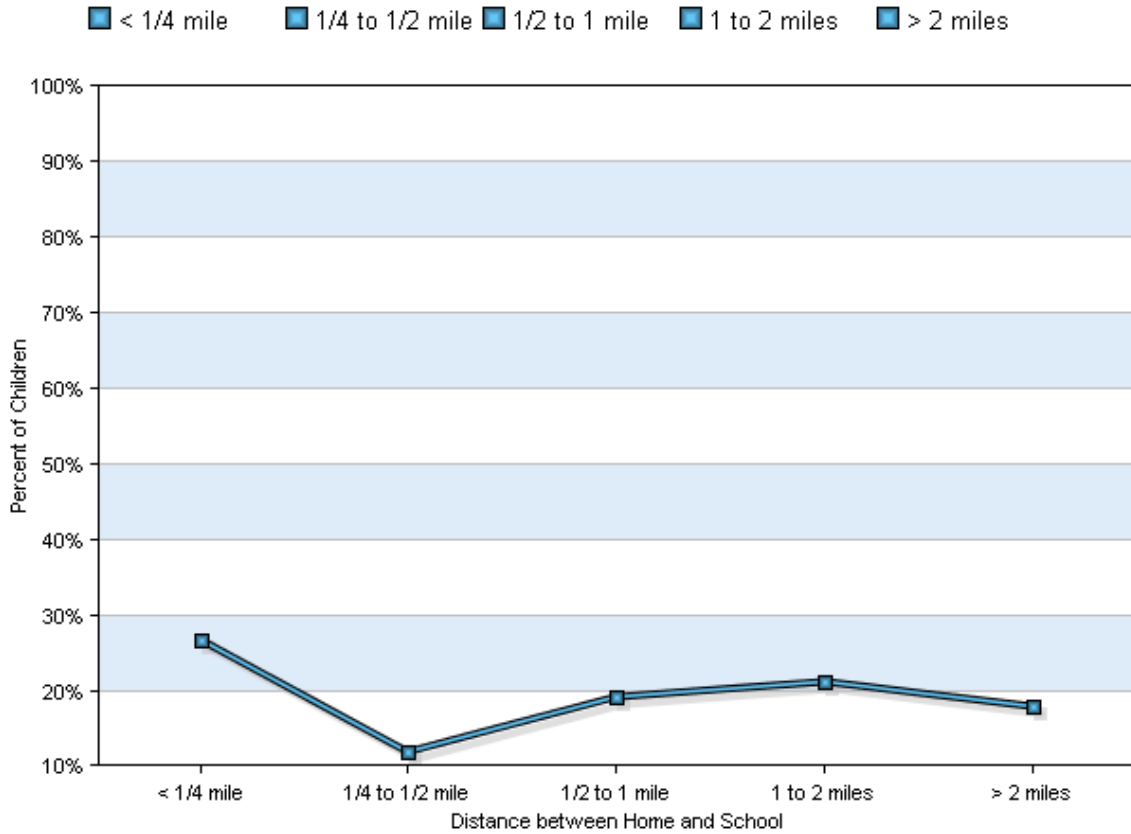

Percent of children who have asked for permission to walk or bike to/from school by distance they live from school

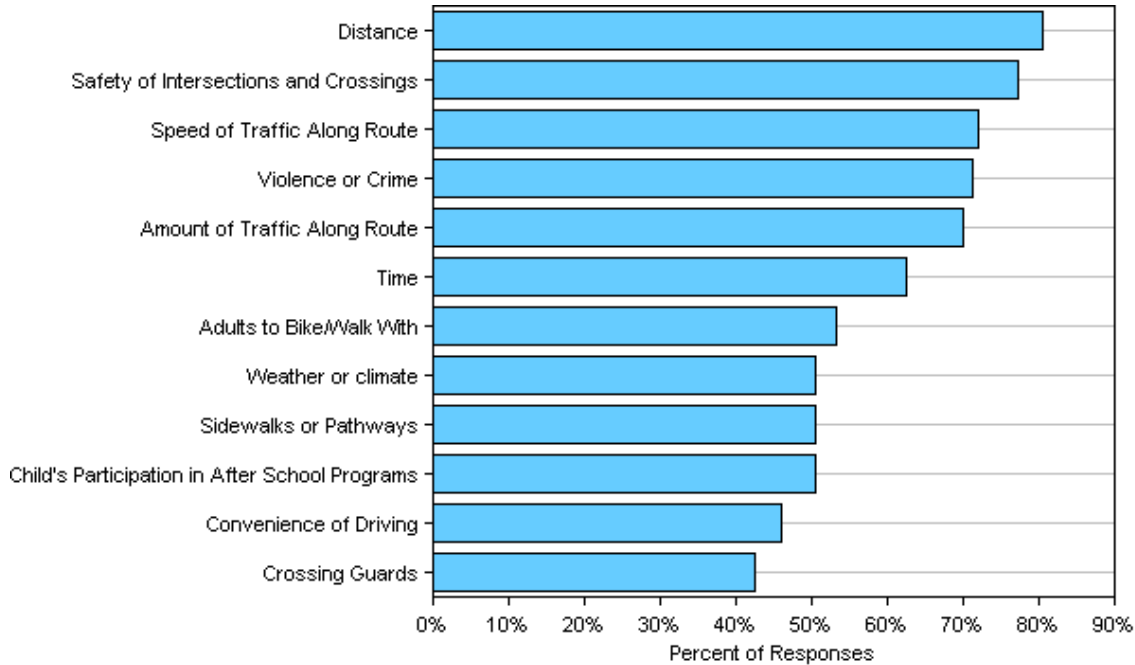


Percent of children who have asked for permission to walk or bike to/from school by distance they live from school

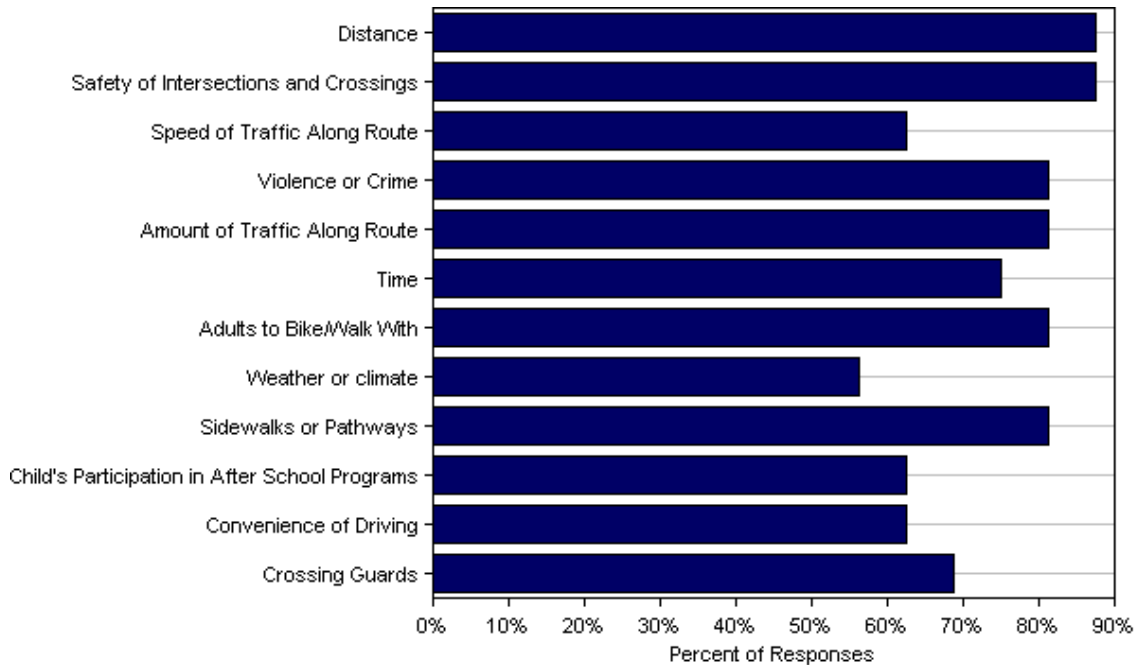

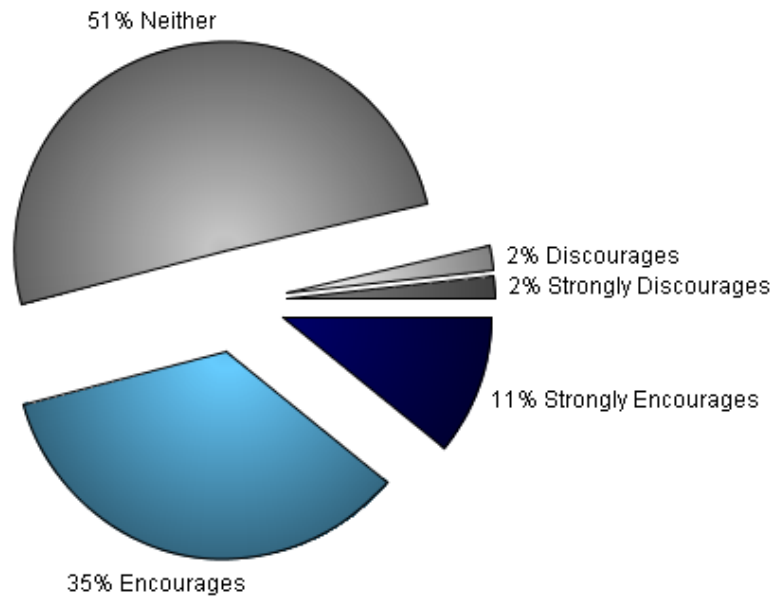

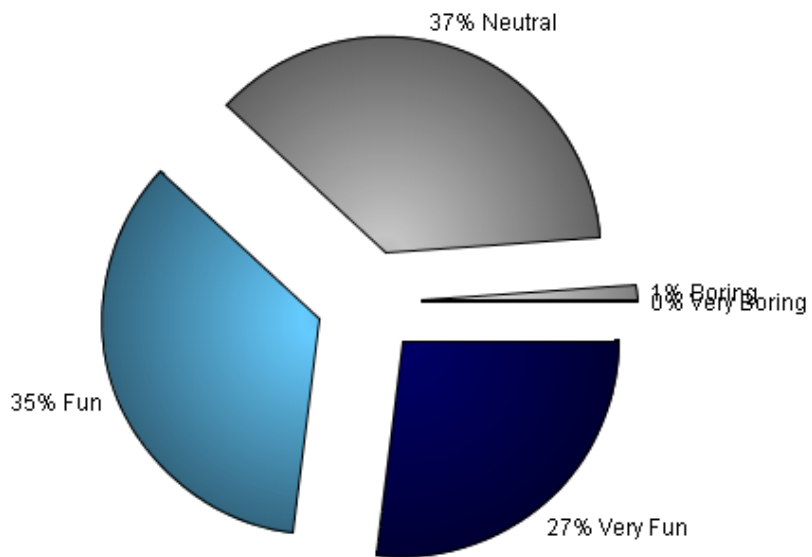

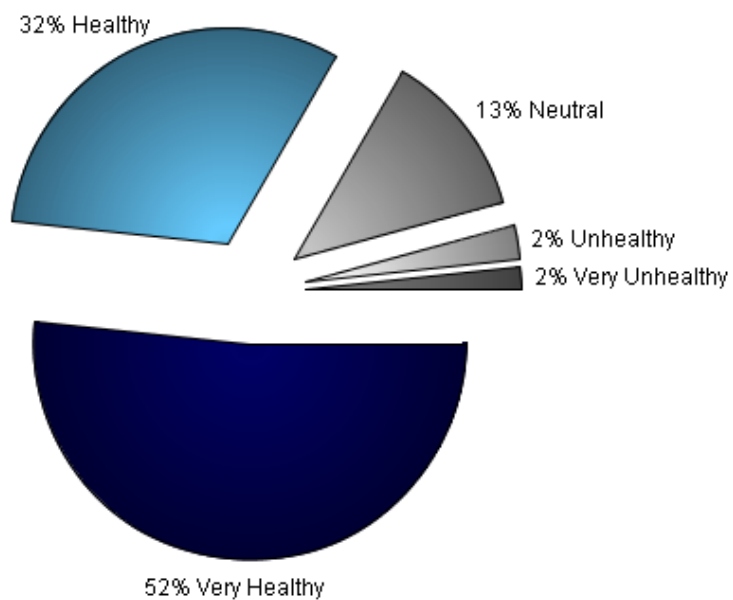
Parents' opinions about how much their child's school encourages or discourages walking and biking to/from school

480477	We love to ride bikes to school, but my wife worries about safety and discourages it because of traffic on Bayshore Blvd. We can't let them go alone because it's too dangerous.

485944	The reason we don't ride our bikes to school is the school does not provide a safe bike rack where bikes are not vandalized. We would love to ride our bikes and only use the car to make this special trip.
